News of the ETR	Our transversal representation team met on Friday, 21 September, from 10 am to 4 pm, in Paris at the General Secretariat of Catholic Education. We had lunch with the Permanent Commission. Gloria Parra prepares the statement of conclusions. Next meeting: Friday, 20 September 2019, 10 am to 4 pm, Paris.
Geneva	In Geneva (Human Rights, UNO), the OIEC is represented by the OIDEL. A major part of the work is done by Ignasi Grau, who is very close to the permanent missions and the special rapporteurs (thematic or geographic). Huguette Ouedraogo, intern, has several times spoken for the OIEC at the General Assembly. Christine N'Go Wenang prepares the communications for the Universal Periodic Review (UPR). In progress: The 31st session of the Universal Periodic Review. We are preparing a communication on the Central African Republic. The 39th session of the Human Rights Council. Strasbourg	Bernard Senelle (Dominican) and Pierre Dussère represent the OIEC at the Council of Europe. As such they are involved in the commissions and working groups of the conference of INGOs (two sessions per year). A project: a side event on 17 January 2019. The OIEC participes in two platforms: The CINGO, which qui regroups the more or less Christian-inspired NGOs. A branch of the Forum of Rome, with the outlines still not defined. Paris	The representation team to the UNESCO is changing. Gloria Parra is learning about the dynamics of NGOs within the UNESCO. She has been involved in the preparation committee for the next Forum, 26 to 28 September in Tunis, entitled "A Different Perspective on Human Migration".
