The High-Level political forum (HLPF) is the United Nations' central platform for monitoring and reviewing the Agenda 2030 and the sustainable development goals (SDGs) adopted by the GA of the UNO on 25 Sept. 2015. For its July 2019 meeting the HLPF is seeking the input of the OIEC:

- What are regional differences, if any?
- Do these differences cause implementation problems? If yes, how?
- What sort of targets and metrics should NGOs use to ensure our definition of **quality education** can be delivered?
- What are immediate steps/actions NGOs can take to deliver our definition of **quality education**?
