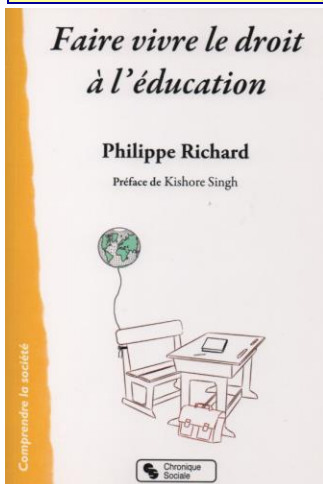


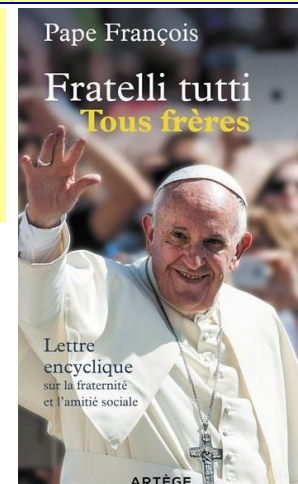

<p>OIEC News</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The 96th Executive Council met (in video) on October 14th and 16th. Not so easy to bring together India, the Philippines, the United States, Latin America, South Africa etc. at the same time. Among the topics discussed: revision of the statutes, solidarity Lebanon, proposals by Quentin Wodon, presentation of Scholas Occurrentes (scholasoccurrentes.org), collaboration with our Protestant equivalent (GPEN), next congress (19-21 Oct. 2022) in Marseille. In planning: a white paper on the international representation of the OIEC. Doc 1 appendix: webinar report from Oct 6, 2020 (Gloria). Doc 2 (book): OIEC contribution to the Global Education Pact. Doc 3: n° 6 (fall 2020) of the Educatio Si Bulletin (see also http://oiecinternational.com/fr/gce-et-cegri/). Among other things, it contains a message from Ms. Azoulay on the occasion of the Global Education Pact.
<p>Strasbourg, Council of Europe</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Doc 4: Bernard Senelle and Pierre Dussère (Council of Europe) affixed the signature of the OIEC at the bottom of a declaration by Pax Christi International. The OIEC participates in CINGO meetings, a place of sharing and monitoring of manipulations by intolerant ideologies or by personal ambitions. A "white paper" being prepared by the Education & Culture committee on "European cultural identity", a mosaic of contributions that the OIEC does not approve of and which has been notified by mail. In this context, it is difficult to follow the evolution of the Conference of INGOs (internal regulations, upcoming elections, concerns about its real place in the Council of Europe despite the support of the new Secretary General in her speech of 15 Oct. plenary assembly). The trip of Cardinal Parolin (n° 2 of the Holy See) scheduled for Thursday, November 12 is compromised, pandemic obliges.
