Paris Unesco

- In the person of Roseline, the OIEC is applying for the NGO Liaison Committee (elections during the GA 16-17-18 December).
- Annex 8 of ETR 12 presented a Unesco text on the *Future of Education* consultation. Several contributions are being prepared to which the OIEC is more or less associated:
 - A focus group organized by the OIEC and GPEN (Global Network of Protestant Schools), CHRISTIAN SCHOOLS AND THE FUTURES OF EDUCATION: <https://www.globalcatholiceducation.org/research> or <http://oiecinternational.com/> or <https://www.gpenreformation.net/>
 - A discussion group moderated by Gloria Parra with 11 students and 2 chaperones from the "La Salle Saint-Denis" high school, on three themes:
 - 1: *Our Changing World: How do you see the future?*
 - 2: *The Purpose of Education*
 - 3: *Implications for Learning.*
 Note: the applause of the high school students at the end of this discussion group!
 - A discussion group led by Roseline Moreau: **Dialogue between people of different cultures and philosophical and religious convictions"**
 - Participation in a discussion group with the CCIC (a platform of Catholic NGOs with Unesco). Theme: **Critical thinking.**
- Possible personal contributions "reflections on how education can be used to shape the future of humanity and the planet." UNESCO question: what is the key issue for education futures? (1000 words max). Write directly to the
